


LATITUDE: 36° 09' S. LONGITUDE: 144° 46' E.
ALTITUDE: 320 feet. MAG. DEC.: 8½° E.
AIR MAPS: Sheet K.8. Strip: 30.

POSITION and LANDMARKS: 1½ miles S of Echuca and within the fork of the Railway Junction.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open, suitable for forced landings.

APPROACHES: E - Telegraph line on rifle range; W - Telegraph line along railway; N and S - open.

MARKINGS: White circle, corner marks at mouth of eastern arm, and two wind indicators.

DESCRIPTION: An irregular area of level sandy loam, affording runs of 720 and 800 yds. (see sketch).

REFUELLING and REPAIRS: Limited facilities in town.

HANGARS: Nil.

WATER SUPPLY: Rain water tank at Rifle Range.

TELEPHONE: Echuca.

TOWN and RAILWAY: Echuca.

CHARGES: Nil.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Soft after rains.
