


DATA SHEET FOR LANDING GROUND NO.541 MENDOORAN, N.S.W.

LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: $31^{\circ} 49' S$; LONGITUDE: $149^{\circ} 05' E$; MAG. VAR: $8^{\circ} E$ app.
 ALTITUDE: 1,171 feet.
 POSITION: About 2 miles W of Mendooran on the Castlereagh River.
 RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet J.9.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Cultivated, suitable for forced landings.
 LANDMARKS: Castlereagh River about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile N & E, windmill to SW.
 APPROACHES: With the exception of a few trees and small creek along W boundary the approaches are clear.
 MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
 Tins painted white on N & W boundaries, and top of posts painted white on E & S boundaries.
 DIMENSIONS: N-S, 720 yds. NW-SE, 720 yds.
 SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Mendooran, 2 miles E.
 TELEPHONE: At house $\frac{3}{4}$ mile ESE.
 HANGARS: Nil.
 REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Mendooran.
 WATER: At houses $\frac{3}{4}$ mile ESE.

PROPRIETORS: Chamber of Commerce, Mendooran.
 CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Not to be used immediately after heavy rain.
