



NOTICE TO AIRMEN.

ARCHERFIELD, Q'LD.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.

POSITION: 7 miles S of Brisbane G.P.O., and 1 mile W of Kyogle railway line. Lat. $27^{\circ} 34\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long. $153^{\circ} 01'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 9° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles SSW of Salisbury railway junction. Mt. Gravatt, 631 feet, 4 miles ENE.

MARKINGS: Ground mark and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Good, grassed surface. Falls to SW corner.

DIMENSIONS: North-South: 1,260 yards. East-West: 1,310 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 50 feet approx.

APPROACHES: North: clear. East: clear, except in way of hangars. South: clear. South east: house, anemobiograph pole 35 feet high and tel. line. West: cleared approach.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Partly timbered and built on with some open spaces. Suitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: On aerodrome.

WATER SUPPLY AND ELECTRICITY: Aerodrome connected to city supply.

WORKSHOPS: On aerodrome.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Several hangars, up to 90 feet span.

TELEPHONE: At Caretaker's quarters. Number: J.8028.

TELEGRAPH: Coopers Plains P.O., $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles east.

NEAREST TOWN: South Brisbane.

RAILWAY STATION: Coopers Plains.

REMARKS: Hangar allotments are available for leasing from the Civil Aviation Board. Strip map Nos. 2, 3, 40, & 49.
