



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

AULD'S PONDS, N.T.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.

POSITION: 16 miles south by west of Daly Waters.

Lat: $16^{\circ} 29' S$; Long: $133^{\circ} 20' E$.MAGNETIC VARIATION: $4^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Clearing in timber, with telegraph line on immediate east.

MARKINGS: White cross, wind indicator and corner marks.

SURFACE: Good level surface, boggy after rain.

DIMENSIONS: NW.-SE. 740 yards. NE.-SW. 660 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 800 feet approx.

APPROACHES: Over timber in all directions. Timber has been felled at ends of landing strips to a depth of 10 chains.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough, unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL & OIL: Daly Waters, 16 miles north by east.

WORKSHOPS & HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

WATER SUPPLY: No. 5 bore, 4 miles north alongside road.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Daly Waters, 16 miles north by east.

NEAREST TOWN: Birdum, 65 miles north by west, by road.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Birdum, 65 miles north by west, by road.

REMARKS: Stripmap No. 7.
