




LICENSED AERODROME - B CLASS



LATITUDE: 20° 1' S; LONGITUDE: 148° 12½' E; MAG. VAR. 7° E app.

ALTITUDE: 20 feet approx.

POSITION: Two miles south-west from Bowen Post Office.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet F.9, Stripmap Nos. 62, 63, 66.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally timbered with some open spaces suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Salt works ½ mile east, North Coast railway line on north boundary and to the west.

APPROACHES: Tel. line 25 ft. high along railway to the north, clear in all other directions except for few trees on west.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 600 yards. E-W, 900 yards.

SURFACE: Smooth, level surface.

TOWN and RAILWAY: Bowen, ½ mile NE. (Don Siding adjacent).

TELEPHONE: At Salt Works, 500 yards east. (Bowen No. 173).

HANGARS: Nil at present.

REFUELLING: Bowen, or on aerodrome by arrangement.

REPAIRS: Bowen garages, 2 miles west.

WATER: Houses nearby.

PROPRIETORS: Wangaratta Shire Council. P.O. Box 53, Bowen, Qld.

CHARGES: Casual - 1-4 seater 3/- per landing.

5-9 " 5/- " "

Over-9 " 7/6 " "

Charges for per annum and for service machines by arrangement with proprietors.

SPECIAL REMARKS: B Class license for favourable winds only.
After continuous heavy rain ground liable to be soft.
