



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

BROCK'S MONUMENT, VIC.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.

POSITION: Situated $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles W.N.W. of Romsey and $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles S.S.W. of Rochford. Lat.: $37^{\circ} 20'$ S. Long.: $144^{\circ} 41'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 8° East approx.

LANDMARKS: Brock's Monument, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile S.S.W.

Road along North boundary.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Fairly level surface lightly grassed. Some furrows run East and West. Liable to be wet in winter, but not boggy.

DIMENSIONS: North-South 490 yards; East-West 540 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 1,800 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: North - tel. line and scattered trees along road, then open. South - rising ground, trees on ridge about 200 yards. East - clear. West - clear for 200 yards, then low trees.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered to South. Remainder small cultivation paddocks. Forced landings barely possible.

PETROL, OIL AND WORKSHOPS: Romsey garages, about 4 miles East.

WATER SUPPLY: At Rifle Range, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile South.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: Mr. J. Anderson, Romsey 38.

TELEGRAPH: Romsey P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Rochford, about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles N.N.W.

RAILWAY STATION: Romsey, about 4 miles.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: Ground is best for landings in East or West directions. Strip-map No.30.
