



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

BUNDABERG, QLD.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for use by all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Bundaberg City Council.

POSITION: About 2½ miles south-west of Bundaberg -

Lat. 24°54' S., Long. 152°19' E.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Triangular shaped ground in timber.

Road along west boundary. Farm buildings south-west.

MARKINGS: Circle.

DESCRIPTION: Generally smooth and level surface with slight fall towards centre of north east boundary. Should be suitable for use in wet weather.

DIMENSIONS FOR LANDING: N.E. - S.W. 750 yards.

N.W. - S.E. 750 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 40 feet approx.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 7°51' E. approx.

APPROACHES: West - telephone line and scrub 30 ft. high. On all other sides the timber has been fallen stump high for a distance of 5 chains back from the edge of the landing area.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat and timbered but with some open patches.

PETROL AND OIL: Bundaberg.

WATER SUPPLY: None on ground.

WORKSHOPS: Garages and foundry in Bundaberg.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: P.O. Bundaberg.

NEAREST TELEGRAPH: P.O. Bundaberg.

NEAREST TOWN: Bundaberg 2½ north east.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Bundaberg.
