


 POSITION: On south-east edge of park, and in township of Cleve.
 RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator sheet J.7. Strip map No.16.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally clear and suitable for forced landings except towards north, where it is rough and hilly.
 LANDMARKS: ½ mile south-east of township of Cleve.
 APPROACHES: North, over 50 ft. hill. tel. line and road;
 South, over cleared paddocks and road; East, over cleared paddocks; West, over tel. line and road.
 MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
 DIMENSIONS: N-S, 660 yards; E-W, 660 yards.
 SURFACE: Good.

 REFUELLING: Cleve.
 REPAIRS: Garages at Cleve.
