



WIRELESS MAST AT CLEVEDON, QLD.



A high wireless mast has been erected at the position as shown on the sketch above.

CLEVEDON REGIONAL BROADCASTING STATION, 4 QN.

Lat: $19^{\circ} 21' 17''$ S. Long: $147^{\circ} 00' 44''$ E.
Approx. $14\frac{1}{2}$ miles E.S.E. from Townsville, and 3 miles N. by W. from Clevedon Railway Station. Stripmaps Nos. 40 and 41.
The mast is 500 feet high. Ground level at base is 516 feet. Obstruction lights are displayed at night, and during periods of bad visibility, only while the broadcasting staff is on duty. These lights are at the mast head and at two lower levels. The outer boundaries of the guy anchors are also marked.
