


LATITUDE: $20^{\circ} 10' S$; LONGITUDE: $140^{\circ} 40\frac{1}{2}' E$; MAG. VAR. $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. app.
ALTITUDE: 500 feet approx.

POSITION: 40 miles NNE of Cloncurry and $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles south of Clonagh Station.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Plains with patches of timber.
