


LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 31°37' S. LONGITUDE: 132°05' E. MAG. VAR: 3° E. approx.
ALTITUDE: 100 feet approx.

POSITION: 60 miles WNW of Penong, on northern side of overland telegraph line.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Stripmaps Nos.16 and 35. Mercator Sheet No. J.6.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating and timbered, with open patches suitable for forced landings. Care must be taken to avoid rabbit warrens.

LANDMARKS: Colona homestead adjacent to western boundary. Telegraph line about 200 yards SW.

APPROACHES: North - clear. South - over overland telephone line. East - over few clumps of trees near boundary. West - over homestead and few trees near boundary.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 770 yards; NE-SW 550 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: Yalata (Port), 24 miles SE.

RAILWAY STATION: Penong, 60 miles ESE.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Homestead, small supply of fuel only.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Yalata Ltd., 99 King Street, Melbourne, Vic.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: This country is treacherous after rain, and if water is lying on aerodrome, those parts will be boggy.
