




LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE:  $18^{\circ} 12\frac{1}{2}'$  S; LONGITUDE:  $142^{\circ} 18'$  E; MAG. VAR:  $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E.  
ALTITUDE: 350 feet.

POSITION: About  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles east of Croydon township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.8, Stripmap No.63.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, few open spaces with old diggings and mullock heaps. Generally unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Bough shed near centre of NE-SW run.

APPROACHES: NNW - over open country and trees; NE - over stumps and trees; SSE - over stumps and trees; SW - over clear country and trees.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 775 yds. NNW-SSE, 775 yds.

SURFACE: Fair. Slightly heavy after rain. Small area near wind indicator and a larger area on opposite side of ground liable to be boggy when wet.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Croydon,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles.

TELEPHONE: Croydon Post Office.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Croydon.

WATER: Houses nearby.

PROPRIETORS: Croydon Shire Council.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: NE-SW runway most suitable for use in wet weather. Caution should be exercised after rain or in conditions of high temperature. "C" Class in dry weather only.
