


 POSITION: Adjacent to the Cue-Pinnacles road, 2 miles south-east of Cue.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H. 3.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Some open patches suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Cue township 2 miles north-west, Cue-Pinnacles road along north-eastern boundary.

APPROACHES: Over low scrub in all directions.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NNW-SSE, 900 yards; ENE-WSW, 900 yards.

SURFACE: Good. Red loamy gravel.

TOWN and RAILWAY STATION: Cue, two miles north-west.

TELEPHONE: Cue.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING and REPAIRS: Cue.

WATER: Cue.
