



## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

DONALD, VIC.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.

POSITION: 1½ miles N.W. of Donald, on N.E. side of Donald - Birchip railway line. Lat.: 36° 22' S. Long.: 142° 58' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 7° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Railway line along southern boundary.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Level, liable to have soft patches after heavy rain.

DIMENSIONS: North-South 1,000 yards; East-West 750 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 370 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: South - tel. lines 22 ft. high. Remainder - clear.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open cultivation, suitable for forced landings.

PETROL, OIL AND WORKSHOPS: Donald, 1½ miles S.E.

WATER SUPPLY: Trough on ground.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Donald.

NEAREST TOWN AND RAILWAY STATION: Donald.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: Aircraft operators are responsible for any damage they cause to stock or other property. It is advisable to give the landowner, Mr. W. Sproat, Donald, 24 hours' notice of intention to land, but such notice will not absolve aircraft operators from responsibility for damage.
