



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.

PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia. (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).

POSITION: 8 miles South-East of Birdum, immediately East of telegraph line.

Lat. $15^{\circ} 42\frac{1}{2}' S.$ Long. $133^{\circ} 19' E.$

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Telegraph line and Birdum Creek to West. Clearing for Railway track Daly Waters - Birdum about 4 miles West.

MARKINGS: White Cross and Wind Indicator.

DESCRIPTION: Crossed landing strips 110 yards wide cleared in timber. Good level surface of red loam and gravel. Should be suitable for use in all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 550 yds.

N.E. - S.W. 550 yds.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 720 ft. approx.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $4^{\circ} E.$ approx.

APPROACHES: Over fallen timber at ends of landing strips.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Heavily timbered and unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Birdum, 8 miles North-West.

WATER SUPPLY: No.2 Bore, 6 miles North-West on road to Birdum.

Water holes in Birdum creek, 1 mile North-West.

WORKSHOPS: Garages at Katherine 125 miles N.W.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: Birdum, 8 miles North-West by road.

NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Birdum, 8 miles North-West by road.

NEAREST TOWN: Birdum, 8 miles North-West by road.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Birdum, 8 miles North-West by road.

REMARKS: Clearing for railway track, about 4 miles West, is not suitable for landing purposes.
