




LATITUDE: 33°22' S. LONGITUDE: 147°56' E. MAG.VAR: 8½° E. app.

ALTITUDE: 800 feet approx.

POSITION: 4½ miles W of Forbes P.O.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.8. Stripmaps Nos. 10, 52 and 60.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Level open paddocks, suitable for forced landings. Timbered area to S.

LANDMARKS: Town of Forbes 4½ miles E; Lachlan River to S.

APPROACHES: E and W - clear; N - over windmill; S - over 25' tel. line and 55' timber.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator. Tops of fence posts painted white.

DIMENSIONS: As per sketch.

SURFACE: Clay pan, short tufty grass. Four gravel runways.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Forbes, 4½ miles E.

TELEPHONE: Forbes.

HANGARS: One 56' by 36'.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Forbes.

WATER: River to south.

PROPRIETORS: Forbes Municipal Council, Town Hall, Forbes, N.S.W.

CHARGES: 1-2 seater planes 2/6 per landing, 30/- per day.
