



LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 31°28' S. LONGITUDE: 147°53' E. MAG.VAR: 8° E. approx.
ALTITUDE: 600 feet approx.
POSITION: 18 miles N of Warren on E bank of Marthaguy Creek.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.8. Stripmap No.60.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scattered trees with open spaces suitable for forced landings.
LANDMARKS: "Haddon Rig" painted on roof of woolshed on SE boundary.
APPROACHES: N, S and W - over scattered trees; E - clear.
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
DIMENSIONS: ENE - WSW, 880 yards; NNW - SSE, 660 yards.
SURFACE: Fair, a few low ridges caused by grader.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Warren, 18 miles S.
TELEPHONE: Homestead, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile S.
HANGARS: Hangar capable of taking one "Moth" plane, folded.
REPAIRS: Warren.
REFUELLING: Homestead.
WATER: Creek adjacent.

PROPRIETOR: G.B.S.Falkiner, Esq., Haddon Rig Station, Warren, New South Wales.
CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots should avoid drains near NE extremity of ground (see plan).
