




HALL'S CREEK, W.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.  
PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.  
POSITION: About 12 miles west of Hall's Creek on Moola Bulla track. Lat:  $18^{\circ} 15' S$ ; Long:  $127^{\circ} 45' E$ .  
MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ . approx.  
LANDMARKS: Large clearing in timber.  
Windmill and tanks about  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile to east.  
MARKINGS: White circle, two wind indicators, boundary marks.  
SURFACE: Level, sandy loam and ironstone soil; S.E. corner likely to be soft after rain, otherwise firm.  
DIMENSIONS: North-South 850 yards; East-West 850 yards.  
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 1,400 feet.  
APPROACHES: Surrounded by timber, felled 200 yds. from boundaries.  
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally unsuitable for forced landings.  
To north and north-east large open black soil plains.  
PETROL & OIL: On aerodrome.  
WORKSHOPS: Wyndham Meat Works, roughly 350 miles north..  
WATER SUPPLY: At windmill about  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile east.  
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Hall's Creek Post Office.  
NEAREST TOWN & SEAPORT: Wyndham, roughly 350 miles north.  
CHARGES: Nil at present.  
REMARKS: Stripmap No. 56.
