


LATITUDE: 26° 24' S; LONGITUDE: 114° 11' E; MAG. VAR: 3° West
 ALTITUDE: 20 feet approx.

POSITION: One mile east of Hamelin Pool Homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet G.3, Stripmap No. 53.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Covered with trees, average height 12 ft.
 Unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Hamelin Pool - Ajana Road along south boundary.
 Homestead 1 mile west.

APPROACHES: Timber 12 ft. high in all directions. Timber
 felled for 5 chains back from south and west boundaries.

Post and wire fence along south boundary.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 770 yards; E-W, 770 yards.

SURFACE: Generally in fair conditions.

TOWN: Carnarvon, approx. 115 miles north, by road.

RAILWAY STATION: Ajana, approx. 110 miles south, by road.

TELEPHONE: At Homestead.

HANGAR: Nil.

REFUELLING: Limited supplies at Homestead.

REPAIRS: Limited resources at Homestead.

WATER: At Homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.
