

LATITUDE: 18° 00' S; LONGITUDE: 140° 34' E; MAG. VAR: 4° E app.

ALTITUDE: 50 feet approx.

POSITION: About one mile north of Inverleigh homestead, on "L" Creek.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.7; Stripmaps Nos. 29, 63 and 64.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough broken country with scattered timber, not suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Homestead and "L" Creek.

APPROACHES: N and E - clear, except for few scattered trees; S and W - over low timber.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator. White line at southern end of NNW-SSE landing strip.

DIMENSIONS: NNW-SSE, 620 yds; WNW-ESE, 400 yds; NE-SW, 600 yds.

SURFACE: Landing strips in good order.

TOWN & SEAPORT: Normanton, 46 miles NE.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: At homestead.

REFUELLING: Limited supply at homestead.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETOR, Mr. W.H. Chandler, Cobbold, via Normanton, Nth. Qld.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Caution is to be used after rain or in conditions of high temperature.
