


EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 15° 39' S; LONGITUDE: 128° 41' E; MAG. VAR: 3° E app.
ALTITUDE: 200 ft. approx.

POSITION: ¼ mile east of Ivanhoe Homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet D.5, Stripmaps Nos.24, 28 and 56.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, but open flats exist where forced landings may be possible.

LANDMARKS: Homestead, Billabong, and high hill to west.
River Ord to east.

APPROACHES: Over low timber in all directions. Felling around ground (see sketch).

MARKINGS: White cross, wind indicator and ground marks.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 910 yards long by 50 yards wide. NE-SW, 660 yards long by 50 yards wide.

SURFACE: Two graded strips maintained in fair condition, remainder of ground rough and sandy.

TOWN and SEAPORT: Wyndham, 50 miles north-west.

TELEPHONE: Nine Mile Store, 41 miles north-west towards Wyndham.

HANGAR: Nil.

REPAIRS: Wyndham Meat Works.

REFUELLING: Limited supplies at Homestead.

WATER: At Homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.
