


EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: $33^{\circ} 16\frac{1}{2}'$ S. LONGITUDE: $138^{\circ} 36'$ E. MAG.VAR: 6° E. app.
ALTITUDE: 1500 feet approx.

POSITION: Situated approx. $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles south of town of Jamestown.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator sheets J.7. Stripmap No.36.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open.

LANDMARKS: Town, railway line, and racecourse to the north.
Main road along the eastern boundary.

APPROACHES: North - clear. West and south - few clumps of trees 50 ft. high. East - telephone line 25 ft. high.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 1050 yds. E-W, 520 yds.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Jamestown, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles north.

TELEPHONE: At Jamestown.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: At Jamestown.

WATER: At racecourse.
