


CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for light types of land-planes only.

PROPRIETORS: Kilcoy Shire Council, Kilcoy, Queensland.

POSITION: $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles west of Kilcoy.

Lat. $26^{\circ} 57' S$. Long. $152^{\circ} 32' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $8\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Show Ring, stockyard and buildings adjacent to western boundary. Road and lagoon adjacent to south.

MARKINGS: White semi-circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Surface likely to be soft after continuous rain.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 500 yards. E. - W. 50 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 350 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Marred by numerous obstructions and rising ground - see sketch above.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hilly and timbered, unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Kilcoy $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles east.

WATER SUPPLY: Tanks at adjacent showground buildings.

WORKSHOPS: Kilcoy garages.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: Kilcoy Shire Council office (Kilcoy 14).

TELEGRAPH: Kilcoy P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Kilcoy $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles east.

RAILWAY STATION: Kilcoy.

CHARGES: 2/6d per landing.

REMARKS: A stockyard obtrudes from show ring into the north-south run.
