


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO. 36/1931.

(MUNICIPAL GROUND)

LISMORE, N.S.W.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: Lismore Municipal Council, Lismore.

POSITION: 1 mile south of South Lismore Railway Station on west side of Richmond River. Lat. $28^{\circ}47'$ S.; Long. $153^{\circ}14'$ E.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Richmond River to east - Railway $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north. Lismore-Casino Road on East.

MARKINGS: Circle in junction of gravel runways. Centre line of runways marked by square concrete blocks. Boundary marks on boundaries and at corners of ground.

DESCRIPTION: Good surface on gravel runways which are about 100 feet wide, remainder unlikely to be suitable for use in wet weather.

DIMENSIONS FOR LANDING: N.E. - S.W. Runway 620 yards
N.W. - S.E. " 620 yards

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 40' approx.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $8^{\circ}41'$ E. approx.

APPROACHES: North and West - Clear. South - Isolated trees. East - Telephone and E.L. wires 30' high.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Low mountains and hills with few flat paddocks suitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: South Lismore 1 mile north.

WATER SUPPLY: Tap near North-east corner of Aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: South Lismore 1 mile north.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: At Private houses along Lismore road.

NEAREST TELEGRAPH: South Lismore P.O. 1 mile north.

NEAREST TOWN: South Lismore 1 mile north.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: South Lismore.

CHARGES: 1. Up to 5 passengers capacity excluding pilot, 5/- per landing.

2. Over 5 passengers capacity, 10/- per landing.

3. Pleasure Flights, £1 per day or part thereof.

REMARKS: Pilots are advised to land on and take off from runways when practicable. Grazing on the aerodrome is permitted, and the Council should be notified by pilots intending to land.
