



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

LISSADELL STN., W.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome, suitable for light types of land-planes only.

PROPRIETORS: Lissadell Pastoral Coy., G/o. Mr. T. Naughton, Argyle Downs, W.A.

POSITION: On West bank of Ord River, about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile East of Lissadell Homestead. Lat.: $16^{\circ} 32\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long.: $128^{\circ} 39\frac{1}{2}'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 3° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Ord River immediately to East; Lissadell Homestead (white roofs) to West; Mt. Evelyn about 5 miles S.W.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator.

SURFACE: Good, suitable in all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: N.E.-S.W. 550 yards; N.W.-S.E. 450 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 500 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: N.W. and W. - open; S.E. - timber felled 200 yards back from boundary; Remainder - scattered trees.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Blacksoil plains, suitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Nil.

WATER SUPPLY: Homestead.

WORKSHOPS: Blacksmith's shop at homestead.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Turkey Creek, 48 miles S.W. by road.

NEAREST TOWN AND SEAPORT: Wyndham, 130 miles by road.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

REMARKS: Relative strip-map No. 56.
