


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

## WIRELESS MASTS AT DOOEN &amp; LONGFORD, VIC.



A high wireless mast has been erected at each of the following positions, as shown on the sketches above.

DOOEN REGIONAL BROADCASTING STATION, 3 WV.

Lat:  $36^{\circ} 38' 34''$  S. Long:  $142^{\circ} 15' 30''$  E.

Approx. one mile North of Dooen Railway Station.

Stripmap No.5.

The mast is 660 feet high. Ground level at base is 452 feet.

Obstruction lights are displayed at night and during periods of bad visibility only while the broadcasting staff is on duty.

These lights are at the mast head and at three lower levels.

LONGFORD REGIONAL BROADCASTING STATION, 3 GI.

Lat:  $38^{\circ} 11' 15''$  S. Long:  $147^{\circ} 05' 50''$  E.

Approx.  $6\frac{1}{2}$  miles S. by E. from Sale or 3 miles S. by E. from Longford. Stripmap No.43.

The mast is 505 feet high. Ground level at base is 333 feet.

Throughout the night, and during other periods of bad visibility, red lights are displayed at the mast head and at two lower levels. The outer boundaries of the guy anchors are also lighted.
