


LANDING GROUND NO. 336
MALLABAH, N.T.
EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 17° 23' S; LONGITUDE: 129° 55' E; MAG. VAR. 3° E app.
ALTITUDE: 700 feet approx.
POSITION: On Limbunnya - Inverway motor track, 70 miles west of Wave Hill Station.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.5; Stripmap Nos. 1 & 24.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Bracken and light timber.
LANDMARKS: Mallabah Waterhole, 8 miles NNW.
APPROACHES: Timber felled back 10 chains at each end of ground.
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.
DIMENSIONS: 770 yards long by 220 yards wide.
SURFACE: Hard light soil over limestone. Should be good in all weathers.

TOWN: Hall's Creek, 230 miles south-west by road.
SEAPORT: Wyndham, 245 miles north-west by road.
TELEPHONE: Wireless telephone at Wave Hill Station, 98 miles east by road.
HANGARS: Nil.
REFUELLING and REPAIRS: Wave Hill Station.
WATER: Mallabah Waterhole, 8 miles NNW, or adjacent creeks in wet season.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.
CHARGES: Nil.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Nearest habitation is at Limbunnya Station, 14 miles NNW.
