


GOVERNMENT AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 29°40' S. LONGITUDE: 138°04' E. MAG. VAR: 5° E. approx.

ALTITUDE: 300 feet approx.

POSITION: About ½ mile west of Marree township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet H.7. Stripmaps Nos. 70 and 71.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally clear; flat to undulating, with gutters and washouts.

LANDMARKS: Marree township ½ mile east, railway line north and east. Small cemetery on SW corner of landing ground.

APPROACHES: North - over railway line; east - over township; west and south - clear.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: E-W, 830 yards; N-S, 960 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Marree, ½ mile east.

TELEPHONE: Marree P.O.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Nil.

REFUELLING: On aerodrome.

WATER: Marree.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.
