




LATITUDE:  $21^{\circ}58\frac{1}{2}'$  S. LONGITUDE:  $115^{\circ}02\frac{1}{2}'$  E. MAG. VAR:  $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. app

ALTITUDE: 50 feet approx.

POSITION: 2 miles north of Minderoo homestead on east side of Ashburton River.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet F.3. Stripmap No.54.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scrubby with occasional claypans.

LANDMARKS: Overland telegraph line and Ashburton River to west. Woolshed  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile south. Concrete bridge over river is prominent landmark.

APPROACHES: North - over sandhills 20' high; south - over cleared approach in scrub about 10' high; east - over fence, otherwise clear; west - low scrub and sandhills.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator on mound.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 660 yards; N-S, 620 yards.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN & SEAPORT: Onslow, about 30 miles north.

TELEPHONE: Minderoo homestead, 2 miles south.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Onslow.

REFUELLING: Limited quantity.

WATER: At woolshed.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.
