

LATITUDE: 17° 22' S; LONGITUDE: 141° 51' E; MAG. VAR: 4° 30' E app.
 ALTITUDE: 50 feet approx.
 POSITION: 63 miles NNW of Croydon and 55 miles ENE of Normanton.
 RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.7. Stripmap No.63.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat black soil plains with scattered timber about 30' high. Suitable for forced landings in places.
 LANDMARKS: Miranda Downs Head 3 miles NNE. Gilbert R. 7 miles N.
 APPROACHES: NW - over stumps and timber. NE - over gullies and timber. SE - clear. SW - Over stumps and timber.
 MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator. White posts along boundaries as shown in sketch.
 DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 790 yds. E-W, 770 yds.
 SURFACE: Hard claypan - good in all weather.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Normanton (70 miles by road).
 TELEPHONE: Normanton.
 HANGARS: Nil.
 REPAIRS: Nil.
 REFUELLING: Limited supplies at homestead (3 miles NNE).
 WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Miranda Downs Pastoral Coy., Collins St., Melbourne.
 CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Stock may wander over the ground.
