


NOTICE TO AIRMEN. NO. 39/1929.

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.  
 PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).  
 POSITION: Lat. 18°12'S. Long. 127°29'E. S.W. of Moola Bulla homestead.  
 MAGNETIC VARIATION: About 2½°E.  
 DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Ground is situated under lee of smooth ridge.  
 MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator. Washouts are marked by white boundary marks.  
 DESCRIPTION: Good level surface, ironstone gravel.  
 DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 500 yards.  
                   E. - W. 550 yards.  
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 1,400 feet.  
 APPROACHES: North, over low range of hills; elsewhere over scattered timber.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally unsuitable in immediate vicinity. Country opens out to East.  
 PETROL AND OIL: At homestead.  
 WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.  
 WORKSHOPS: At homestead  
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
 TELEGRAPH: Hall's Creek Post Office, 22 miles East.  
 NEAREST TOWN: Wyndham.  
 REMARKS: Relative Strip Map No. 56.
