



## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO. 71/1936

(AERODROME)

TENNANT CREEK, N.T.



**CLASS OF GROUND:** Aerodrome suitable for single and light multi-engined types of landplanes.

**PROPRIETORS:** Commonwealth of Australia (Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne).

**POSITION:** West of O.T. line and immediately N.W. of township of Tennant Creek. Lat.:  $19^{\circ} 39' S.$ , Long.:  $134^{\circ} 11\frac{1}{2}' E.$

**MAGNETIC VARIATION:**  $4^{\circ} E.$  approx.

**LANDMARKS:** O.T. line to East, township of Tennant Creek immediately South-East.

**MARKINGS:** White circle and wind indicator.

**SURFACE:** Fair, with patches of ironstone gravel on loam.

**DIMENSIONS:** N.-S. 660 yards, E.-W. 660 yards.

**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 800 ft. approx.

**APPROACHES:** North - felled timber; South - hills to 200 ft. and felled approach; East - O.T. Line etc. West - timber to 20 ft. and small hillocks to 35 ft. high.

**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Hilly and timbered.

**PETROL AND OIL:** Tennant Creek immediately to South-East.

**WATER SUPPLY:** " " " " " "

**WORKSHOPS:** " " " " " "

**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** Nil.

**TELEGRAPH AND TELEPHONE:** At P.O.  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile South-East.

**NEAREST TOWN:** Tennant Creek.

**CHARGES:** Nil at present.

**REMARKS:** Heavy after good rains. E.L.G. 7 miles North probably better in wet weather. Relative Strip Map No. 72.
