


WADDELL'S TANK, N.S.W.

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.

PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia, (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).

POSITION: 30 miles S.E. of Bourke, on S.W. side of Nyngan - Bourke railway.

Lat. $30^{\circ}29\frac{1}{2}'S$. Long. $146^{\circ}15'E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $7^{\circ}E$. approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Clearing in timber adjoining railway. Tank in S.E. corner.

MARKINGS: White Cross and Wind Indicator.

DESCRIPTION: L-shaped ground with good surface; should be suitable in all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: E.N.E. - W.S.W. 630 yards.

N.W. - S.E. 630 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 400 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: N.W. approach felled for short distance; otherwise timbered on all sides. Railway line and fence along N.E. boundary.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered.

PETROL AND OIL: Byrock, 14 miles S.E. by road or rail.

WATER SUPPLY: Waddell's Tank, adjoining.

WORKSHOPS: Byrock garage.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: Railway telephone at Dwyer's Siding, 4 miles N.W.

NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Byrock.

NEAREST TOWN: Byrock, 14 miles S.E. by road.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Dwyer's Siding, 4 miles N.W. by road.
