




LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: $33^{\circ} 24\frac{1}{2}' S$; LONGITUDE: $150^{\circ} 03' E$; MAG. VAR: $9^{\circ} E$. app.

ALTITUDE: 3,000 feet approx.

POSITION: 1 mile W of Wallerawang.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.9. Stripmap No.10.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hilly - timbered in places.

LANDMARKS: Railway 170 yds. north and 770 yds. east. Houses near NE boundary.

APPROACHES: North - over trees, hills and railway line; East - clear; South and west - over trees. 20 ft. tel. and 25 ft. E.L. about 100 yds. to NE.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 500 yds. E-W, 660 yds.

SURFACE: Fair, with general fall to NE.

TOWN, RAILWAY STATION & TELEPHONE: Wallerawang, 1 mile east.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Wallerawang.

WATER: At nearby house.

PROPRIETORS: Blaxland Shire Council, Wallerawang, N.S.W.

CHARGE: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: "C" Class in favourable winds only.
