



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

WINNING POOL, W.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of land planes.

PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).

POSITION: Lat. $23^{\circ}09'$ S. Long. $114^{\circ}33'$ E.

Situated about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile North-east of Winning Pool Station.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: About $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Winning Pool Station $\frac{1}{2}$ mile South-west, Woolshed $\frac{1}{4}$ mile West.

MARKINGS: White circle. Wind indicator is on edge of ground, W.S.W. from ground mark.

DESCRIPTION: Limestone gravel, smooth surface. Good in all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 550 yards.

E. - W. 550 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 150 feet.

APPROACHES: Over scattered scrub, about 10 feet high in all directions.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scrubby, with a few open patches.

PETROL AND OIL: Small quantity sometimes available at Station. Onslow nearest sure supply.

WATER SUPPLY: Winning Pool Station, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile South-west.

WORKSHOPS: Onslow, 135 miles North; Carnarvon, 145 miles South.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: Post Office, Winning Pool, 1 mile South-west.

TELEGRAPH: Post Office, Winning Pool.

NEAREST TOWN: Onslow.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: No railway in district. Nearest port is Maud's Landing, about 48 miles West.

CHARGES: Nil.
