




CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.  
 PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.  
 POSITION: About  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile NNE from Wollal Station Homestead.  
 Lat:  $19^{\circ} 46' S$ ; Long:  $120^{\circ} 39' E$ .  
 MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$  approx.  
 LANDMARKS: Wollal Homestead.  
 MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.  
 SURFACE: Level sandy loam surface.  
 DIMENSIONS: N-S: 660 yards; E-W: 660 yards.  
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 25 ft. approx.  
 APPROACHES: Clear except for fence about 2 chains from western boundary.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scrubby.  
 PETROL & OIL: At Landing Ground.  
 WATER SUPPLY: At Homestead.  
 WORKSHOPS: Port Hedland, about 150 miles WSW.  
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
 TELEPHONE: At Homestead.  
 TELEGRAPH: Pedal wireless set at Homestead.  
 NEAREST TOWN & SEAPORT: Port Hedland.  
 REMARKS: The surface of the Landing Ground is liable to have ridges on it, formed by drift sand. Stripmap No.55.
