



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).
POSITION: Lat. 31° S. Long. 123° 32' E. Situated immediately South of railway station at Zanthus on Trans-Australian railway line.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: 0° 15' W. approx.
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: "L"-shaped clearing in timber. Railway settlement to the North.
MARKINGS: White cross and two wind indicators.
DESCRIPTION: Good level surface of red sand. Should be satisfactory during wet weather.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 900 feet.
APPROACHES: Over timber in all directions.
